Population Aging Impact on Elder Care

Syracuse, NY, May 2024

Analyzed PEW research to determine healthcare benefits in each respective Country compared to economic status of its inhabitants. Measured GDP and gave recommendations on each Nigeria and Hong Kong on how to improve individualized and governmental healthcare and financial benefits.

Socioeconomic Status Effects on Greek Life at Syracuse University
